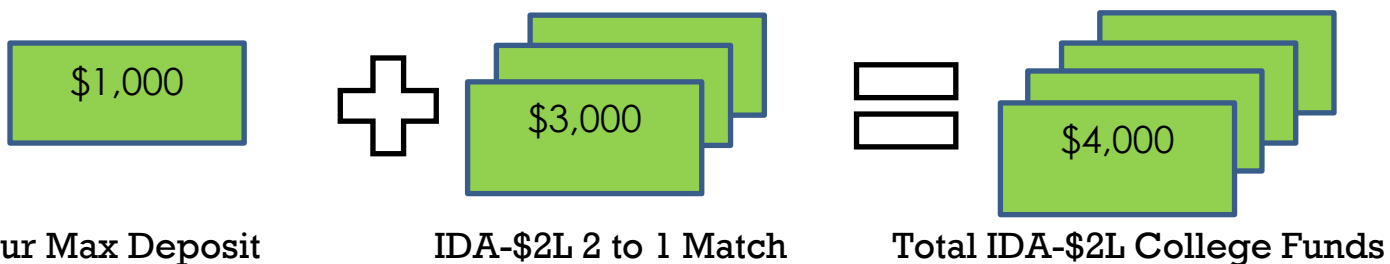

Total IDA-\$2L College Funds

Does the adjusted gross income not exceed \$25,520 a year for your household of one (add \$8,960 for each additional person in your household)? Is your household net-worth \$10,000 or less, excluding a vehicle and/or home if you own them? Are you age 16+, a Coconino County Resident, and have a driver's license / gov. photo ID? If yes for all, you may be eligible to enroll for a Coconino County Individual Development Accounts (IDA) \$ave2Learn (\$2L) post-secondary education grant matching 3:1 up to \$1,000 of your saved earned income. This can turn your \$1,000 into \$4,000 to cover certificate or degree related tuition, fees, books, and supplies per your class syllabi. Coconino County's IDA-\$2L does not disqualify you from scholarships or other grants. For more information, visit: www.coconino.az.gov/ida.
